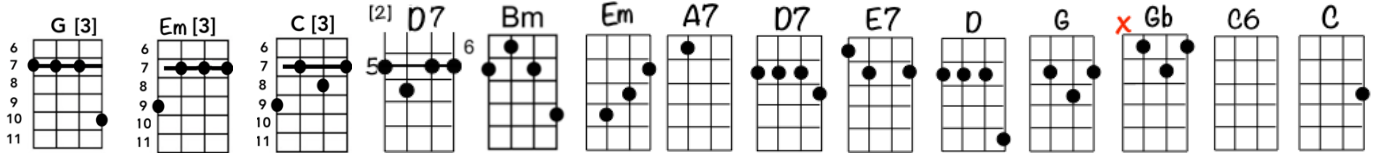




CROCODILE ROCK (L3)
