CAR PARKING: There is limited parking on Lark Lane, but you should be able to park on the perimeter of Sefton Park which is just a few minutes away.


FOOD & REFRESHMENTS: All performers will be provided with a hot or cold beverage and a plate of food. Likely vegan or vegetarian.
